Complaints Lodged

It turns out that Framework does not have to apply to the Council for a change of use for Highclere Lodge. Apparently "elderly" is not defined within the conditions and no age restriction was imposed on the home.

This means that the people who live there can remain until they can return to the City in the New Year.

This problem has taken a long time to resolve and caused local residents a great deal of upset. Much of this could have been avoided if Framework had told people in advance what their plans were. Many of us feel that we were ignored.
